Welcome to our pre-Thanksgiving match outdoors (a tad earlier than last year).

We will appreciate **EVERYONE** helping with the usual posse chores as best as they are able.

All SASS rules and regulations will apply to our match. We **MUST** be finished on the range with targets cleared off by **1 p.m.**. Because of this, we will begin a little earlier closing registration by **9:00 a.m. at the latest.**

Be extremely careful to keep the **muzzles of your firearms pointed in a safe direction, obeying the 170-degree rule.** Keep your finger off of the triggers unless muzzles are pointed toward the target!

Today, we are planning to shoot **five short & fairly easy stages.**

Ammo needed for match:

- Revolver – 50 rounds
- Rifle – 50 rounds
- Shotgun – 16 + rounds



Finally, **PLEASE** observe the three basic rules:

1. **BE SAFE!**
2. **HAVE FUN!**
3. **SHOOT YOUR BEST!**

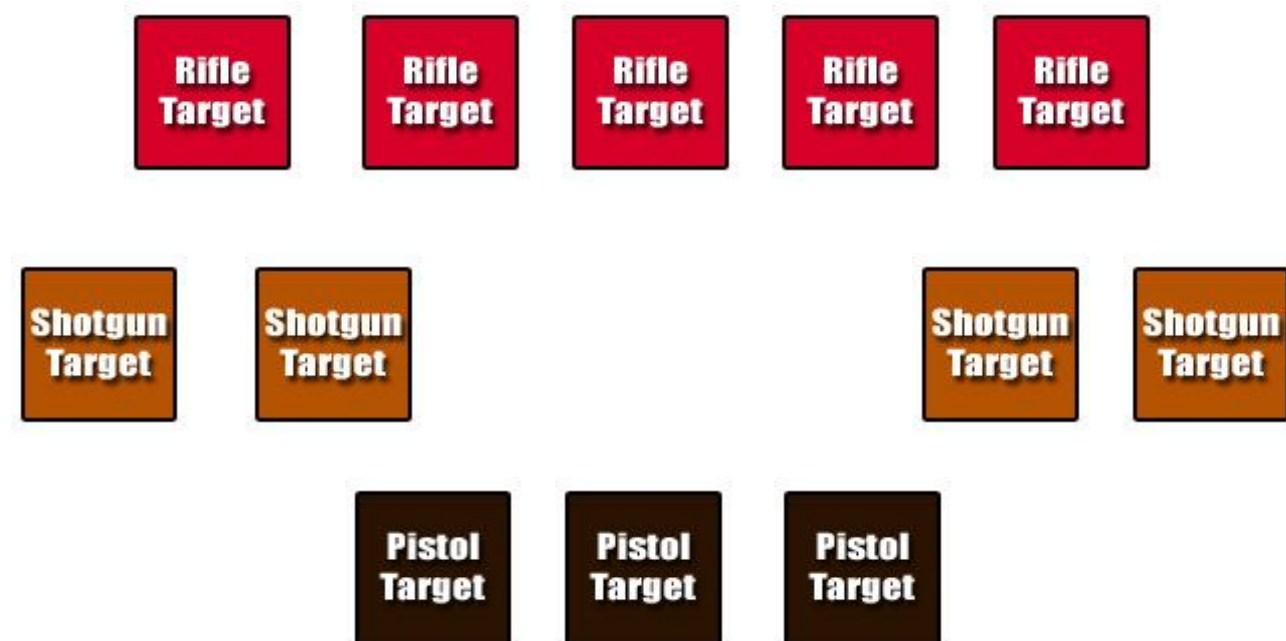

Stage ONE – The Postman Always Rings Twice

Rifle 10 Rounds

Revolvers 10 Rounds

Shotgun 4+ Rounds



Table

Rifle and shotgun are staged on the table. Revolvers are holstered. Shooting order is rifle, revolver, shotgun. One hand is poised over the bell. The other hand can be anywhere but CANNOT BE TOUCHING A GUN.

To Start the Scenario:

RING THE BELL TWICE,

then SAY the Starting Phrase: **The Postman Always Rings Twice!**

The timer will start after you say the phrase. You MUST ring the bell first.

Starting from behind the table, double-tap the rifle targets from either left to right or right to left. [1-1-2-2-3-3-4-4-5-5] Make the rifle safe.

Double-tap the revolver targets in a Nevada sweep [1-1-2-2-3-3-2-2-1-1] or the opposite way.

From the table, shoot the four knock-down shotgun targets in any order until they are down.

After completing the scenario, safely leave the firing line to the unloading table.

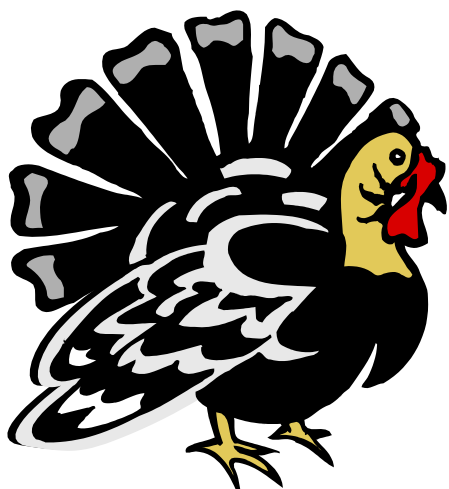
You may shoot at the shotgun targets until down.

Stage TWO – Sweep These Turkeys

Rifle 10 Rounds

Revolvers 10 Rounds

Shotgun 4+ Rounds



Rifle and shotgun are staged on the table.
Revolvers are holstered. Shooting order is rifle, shotgun, revolver.

Shooters start with hands straight down at his/her side and **MAY NOT BE TOUCHING A GUN.**

Starting Phrase:
Sweep these Turkeys!

At the Beep:

Starting from behind the table, single-tap the rifle targets starting on the left or the right in a Nevada sweep. Make rifle safe. [Example 1-2-3-4-5-4-3-2-1-2]

Shoot the four knock-down shotgun targets in any order until they are down.

With the revolvers, single-tap the revolver targets in a **continuous** Nevada sweep.

[Example: 1-2-3-2-1-2-3-2-1-2]

After completing the scenario, then safely leave the firing line to the unloading table.

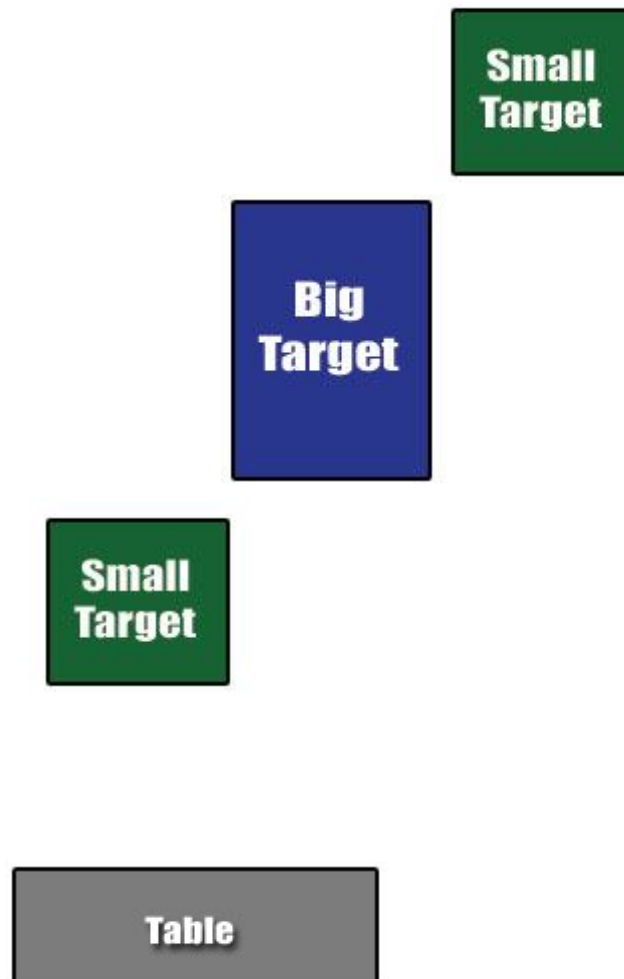
You may shoot at the shotgun targets until down.

Stage THREE – The Quickie!

Revolvers 10 Rounds

Rifles 10 Rounds

NO SHOTGUN



Rifle is staged on the table.

Revolvers are holstered. Shooting order is rifle then revolvers.

Shooters start with hands on his or her hat, hat is on the head.

Starting Phrase:

I always like a quickie!

At the Beep:

Starting from behind the table, shoot the targets with the rifle in the following order: 1-2-2-2-3

Do this two times.

Make rifle safe.

Shoot the revolvers in the identical sequence.

This is the same as one shot on the Small Front Target, 3 shots on the Big Target, one shot on the Small Back Target. After completing the scenario, safely leave the firing line to the unloading table.

Stage Four – Who Likes Pie?

Rifle 10 Rounds

Revolvers 10 Rounds

Shotgun 4+ Rounds



Rifle & shotgun are staged on the table. Revolvers are holstered.
Shooting order is shotgun, rifle, revolver.
Shooter starts behind the table holding the pie pan with both hands.

Starting Phrase: Who Likes Pie?

At the Beep:

Let go of the pie pan and shoot the two shotgun wiggle targets twice each with NO DOUBLE TAPS.

Make the shotgun safe.

With the rifle, shoot the targets in two Arkansas Shuffles starting from the LEFT. [1-1-2-3-3]

Make the rifle safe.

Move down range to the barrier; shoot the revolver targets in two Arkansas Shuffles, starting from the LEFT. [1-1-2-3-3-]

After completing the scenario, safely leave the firing line to the unloading table.

You may re-shoot any un-hit wiggle targets.

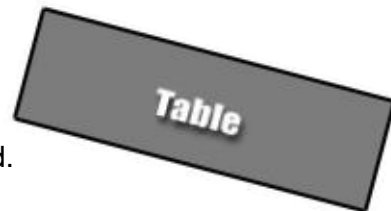


Stage Five – Good Gravy!

Rifle 10 Rounds

Revolvers 10 Rounds

Shotgun 4+ Rounds



Rifle & shotgun are staged on the table. Revolvers are holstered.

Shooting order is rifle, shotgun, revolver.

Shooter starts behind the table holding the wooden spoon with both hands.

Starting Phrase: Good Gravy!

At the Beep:

Let go of the wooden spoon and, with the rifle, shoot the rifle targets in two Arkansas Shuffles [3-3-2-1-1] starting from the RIGHT. Re-stage the rifle safely.

Shoot the wiggle shotgun targets twice EACH with NO DOUBLE TAPS. Re-stage the shotgun safely.

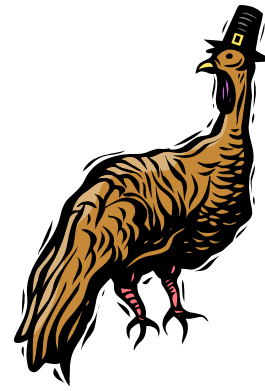
Move down range to the barrier; shoot the revolver targets in two Arkansas Shuffles, starting from the RIGHT [3-3-2-1-1].

After completing the scenario, safely leave the firing line to the unloading table.

You may re-shoot any un-hit wiggle shotgun targets.
