After the match, and after tearing down the stages, we'll gather in the Clubhouse for the posting of the scores and the telling of tall tales.

Hopefully, the grounds will dry up and we'll be able to shoot in the lowland next month.

## Stage 2

Rifle 10 rounds      Revolver 10 rounds      Shotgun 4+

Revolvers are to be loaded with five rounds each, hammer down on the empty chamber, and holstered. The rifle is to be loaded with ten rounds, hammer down on the empty chamber, and staged on the right horse. The shotgun, action open and empty, is staged on the left horse.

The shooter begins by standing behind the right horse, both hands on the horse's behind.

Starting Phrase: **NICE HORSEY**

At the Beep: Get your rifle and shoot the four rifle targets in the following pattern: 1,1,1,2,2,3,3,4,4,4. Make the rifle safe.  
With your revolvers, shoot the revolver targets in the same pattern as the rifle: 1,1,1,2,2,3,3,4,4,4. Make the revolvers safe after use.  
Go to the left horse to get the shotgun. Shoot each shotgun target once in any order. Make the shotgun safe.

After completing the shooting, safely take your guns to the unloading table.

Shotgun misses may be reshot!

Table

Revolvers are to be loaded with five rounds each, hammer down on the empty chamber, and holstered. The rifle is to be loaded with ten rounds, hammer down on the empty chamber, and staged on the table. The shotgun, action open and empty, is staged on the table.

The shooter begins by standing behind the table, both hands holding a money bag..

Starting Phrase: I NEED A DRINK !

At the Beep: Drop the money bag. With the shotgun, shoot each shotgun target once. Make the shotgun safe.  
With the rifle, shoot the rifle targets in a Nevada Sweep: 1,2,3,2,1,2,3,2,1, **Then shoot P2 once.** Make the rifle safe.  
With your revolvers, shoot two Nevada Sweeps from either direction. 1,2,3,2,1 or 3,2,1,2,3. Both must be the same with both revolvers.

After completing the shooting, safely take your guns to the unloading table.

Shotgun misses may be reshot!  
**DON'T FORGET TO SHOOT THE 10<sup>TH</sup> RIFLE SHOT AT P2!**

Revolvers are to be loaded with five rounds each, hammer down on the empty chamber, and holstered. The rifle is to be loaded with ten rounds, hammer down on the empty chamber, and staged on the right. The shotgun, action open and empty, is held by the Shooter.

The Shooter starts behind the left horse, holding the shotgun with both hands.

**Starting Phrase: LET'S START THE SHOOTING!**

**At the Beep:** Get the shotgun and shoot each shotgun target once. Make the shotgun safe. Go to the right horse to fetch your rifle. With your rifle, shoot the rifle targets in a decreasing sweep from the right: 4,3,2,1,4,3,2,4,3,4. Make the rifle safe.

Now, shoot the four revolver targets in a decreasing sweep from the right as with the rifle: 4,3,2,1,4 then 3,2,4,3,4. Make the revolvers safe.

After completing the shooting, safely take your guns to the unloading table.

Shotgun misses may be reshot!

Rifle 10 rounds      Revolver 10 rounds      Shotgun 4+

Revolvers are to be loaded with five rounds each, hammer down on the empty chamber, and holstered. The rifle is to be loaded with ten rounds, hammer down on the empty chamber, and staged on the horse. The shotgun, action open and empty, is staged on the horse. Your guns may be shot in any order, but you cannot end with the rifle.

The Shooter starts standing behind the horse, not touching his guns.

Starting Phrase: THIS WILL BE FAST AND FUN!

At the Beep: With the revolvers, shoot each target twice with two sweeps. No double taps. Make the revolvers safe after use.  
With the rifle, shoot each target twice, with no double taps. Make the rifle safe after use.  
With the shotgun, shoot each shotgun target once, then make it safe.

You can reshoot shotgun targets if necessary.
